

Cambridge Exam Course *Online* for Juniors!
13-17 years only: B2 First for Schools (FCE) preparation
Dates: 6th July – 31st July 2020 (minimum 2 week booking)

10 hours/week of morning classes (two classes/day, **09:00-10:00 & 10:15-11:15**, Monday-Friday + optional social programme with other junior students 7.5 hours per week **12:15-13:45**, all times **UK London time**)

Levels

When you book your course, we will send you a one-hour English placement test, so we can check you are a good level for this Cambridge exam course.

Aims

You and your online classmates will have Cambridge exam classes, Monday to Friday, which will help you to:

- practise the different tasks you have to do for each part of the exam
- learn personal strategies to do the exam tasks more effectively, and to organise your learning
- learn some of the new language required for the exam
- engage in interactive tasks with your classmates online
- have fun!

The syllabus

Your teachers will use a variety of exam-focused worksheets, practice tests, and course book extracts to provide the syllabus for the course. Our syllabus focuses on:

- key topics that are often in the exam
- practice of the Reading and Use of English, Writing, Speaking and Listening tasks in the exam
- the most useful grammar, vocabulary and functional language for the exam

The classes

There are two 60-minute classes per day, making 10 hours per week. Each class has a maximum of 15 students. You will normally have one or two main teachers each week. The two classes have a different focus:

<i>Class</i>	<i>Time</i>	<i>Focus</i>
Class 1	60 minutes	You'll focus on format awareness and strategy practice for the Speaking and the Listening exam papers during the first class. You'll also start the class with our Phrase of the Day to help you sound more natural (useful in the Speaking exam!).
Class 2	60 minutes	You'll focus on format awareness and strategy practice for the Reading and Use of English , and Writing exam papers during the second class.
